These virtual meetings are facilitated by an individual with a professional background in mental health. Each participant is encouraged to share their stories, lessons,

and struggles with the group to find support and learn from each other. This program hopes to help families feel understood, acknowledged, and validated by others who share their same diagnosis and have walked a similar path.
